

DELIVERY AND CONNECTION PROCEEDURE

Thank you for ordering your new Smeg cooker from John Lewis.

Smeg can arrange both a connection service for your new cooker and the option to have your existing one taken away.

If you wish to utilise either of these options please ask your John Lewis Sales Partner for details on costs relating to these services and they can add them to your purchase order.

Please note Smeg will only connect natural gas (not LPG), and any electrical connection required remains your responsibility, and must be carried out by a qualified electrician and conform to all current safety regulations.

Please visit www.smeguk.com for information on the electrical loading requirement for your appliance.

Once your order has been processed Smeg Logistics will get in touch with you to arrange a home delivery booking.

They will give you a 4hr delivery window and you can chose to also have a call one hour prior to delivery on the day should you wish.

When making the booking Smeg will carry out a home delivery questionnaire to ascertain all information relating to access at your property to ensure everything goes smoothly.

If you have requested a gas connection you will be contacted separately by Smeg Service to arrange this, please note this service will usually take place on the next working day following your delivery.

GAS CONNECTION: If connection has been requested your cooker will be supplied with a one metre long mark 2 BS Bayonet Hose with a 1/2" BSP male fitting.

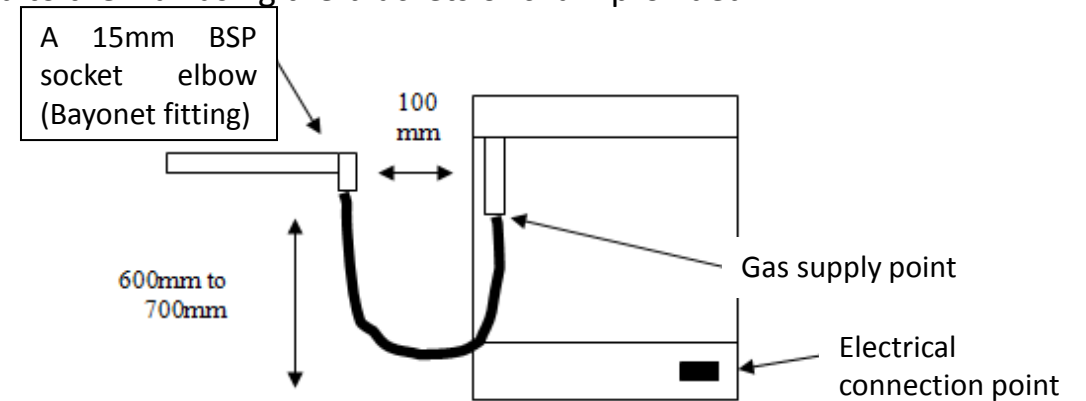
When the engineer attends they will use this to connect your cooker to the gas supply. Please note this is a connection service only. The Smeg engineer will only hook up the gas supply. All pipe work must be in place prior to connection, any remedial work required will not be undertaken and the engineer will not be able to complete connection.

Please check the details opposite to ensure your gas and electrical supplies are in the correct position for your new cooker.

DISPOSAL OF EXISTING COOKER: If you have requested this service please ensure the old product is fully disconnected and ready to be taken away at time of new cooker delivery. If this is not adhered to Smeg Logistics will not be able to return to collect at a later date.

Models beginning: SUK61 / SUK62/ SUK92 / SY62/ SY92 or A1/ A2/ A3/ A4/ A5

The gas Bayonet fitting must terminate to the left-hand side of the cooker when viewed from the rear and must be within 100mm from the edge of left-hand side. The bayonet fitting must be no higher than 700mm and no lower than 600mm from the floor. The appliance must be secured to the wall using the brackets or chain provided.
